We are a MISSIONARY community of brothers and of sisters who choose to live prayer as their priority, and at the same time share their lives with the underprivileged.

Perpetual adoration of the Eucharist in the central community by day and by night is the sign of our CONTEMPLATIVE call that leads us to the mission.

The community is divided into fraternities, small monastic communities among the poor, and follow the spirituality of Charles de Foucauld. Our monasteries have no walls, no other boundaries than the poor.

Fraternity life is of the greatest importance to us in order to live our consecrated life in a fraternal friendship rooted in the Gospel, learning from the life of the holy family of Nazareth. We believe that unity inside the fraternities shows the presence of God even more than miracles.

Side by side of the fraternities a good number of lay people, youth, families and adults who want to answer the call to a life of deep prayer and commitment to the poor, walk alongside with us sharing the spiritual belonging to the Community.

Their spiritual call is lived out as lay people in their own surroundings and in deep communion with the local church.
